This special Summit will make a crucial contribution to the ongoing progress on water issues being led by the AIWW series.

The AIWW Summit 2018 will take place on 14-16 November 2018 in the city of Rotterdam, the Netherlands. It aims to:

- Set the global agenda for the AIWW 2019,
- Reflect on the Amsterdam Agreements and solutions that were shaped during AIWW 2017,

- Build upon the results and outcomes of AIWW 2017 and take the discussions further,
- Intensify global partnerships,
- Provide an opportunity for the AIWW Community to meet, supporting its members in refreshing their enthusiasm and commitment.

AN AGENDA-SETTING PROGRAMME

The AIWW Summit 2018 will be held over three days. The focus is on Thursday 15 November, when the programme will build upon the outcomes and discussions of AIWW 2017. In the morning, there will be parallel sessions on monitoring the Sustainable Development Goals, Start-ups & Scale-ups, progress made on the Amsterdam Agreements, and the outcomes of the High Level Panel on Water. The afternoon consists of a plenary session with keynotes by representatives of government, knowledge institutes and industry and 15 roundtables, all within a framework of the topics of:

- **Water efficiency and value**
Resource recovery, finance, water stewardship, circular water cycle
- **Water management and resilience**
Resilient cities, adaptive measures, monitoring & early warning systems
- **Institutional transition and governance**
Institutional capacity, bankability of utilities, economic resilience
- **Innovative water system implementations**
Micro-pollutants, asset management, ICT & data, desalination

A networking reception and a special Summit dinner (invitation only) wrap up the programme of this day.

The AIWW Summit 2018 gets underway on Wednesday 14 November with closed sessions (see opportunities for side events), and concludes on Friday 16 November with more closed sessions and an excursion programme.

An agenda-setting outcome

The dialogue at the AIWW Summit 2018 will result in a final position paper that will form the basis and inspiration for next year's Amsterdam International Water Week, taking place on 4-8 November 2019.
